## **Doyon Language Online (DLO)**

The DLO courses have lessons that allow students to listen to vocabulary and phrases, repeat the phrases, and practice writing. There are two courses: Denaakk'e and Benhti. Minors under the age of 13 need to have signed permission slips to join. The app does require a base level of literacy so it's best if students were able to read.
