INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS:

Chairperson McGinty asked everyone present to introduce themselves to the District School Board. Present at the meeting were Pat Madros, Kerry Boyd, and Cheryl Brady.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Chairperson McGinty introduced the minutes for March 13, 2013 Regular Board Meeting. Christina Semaken moved to approve the minutes for March 13, 2013. Shirley Kruger seconded the motion. Wilma David called for the question. VOTE: 6/0 YEA, MOTION PASSED (Absent-Eleanor Yatlin).

IDENTIFICATION OF PERSONS DESIRING TO ADDRESS THE BOARD:

Chairperson McGinty opened the floor for anyone wishing to address the School Board letting everyone know that they have 3 minutes for addressing the School Board. Pat Madros, Mayor of Koyukuk addressed the Board welcoming them to Koyukuk. Mr. Madros went through the projects that are pending for the City of Koyukuk.

1. Chairperson McGinty introduced the Board Committee Reports. Kerry Boyd reported on the Certified Hire Committee. Ms. Boyd went through the list of hires that were presented at the committee meeting along with the vacancies. Christina Semaken reported on the Legislative Committee. Funding was secured for Koyukuk School Restroom Restoration and YKSD Classroom Technology. The legislative team of Maurice McGinty, Christina Semaken and Kerry Boyd met with

Representative Guttenberg who represents Manley and Minto, Representative Neal Foster who represents the River Schools, Senator Lyman who represents Manley and Minto and Senator Olson who represents the River Schools. The trip to Juneau turned into a positive outcome with the potential funding secured for Koyukuk School Restroom Restoration and YKSD Classroom Technology. Wilma David reported on the Curriculum Committee. The committee meets with Chane Beam and discussed the direction for Curriculum in the District. Language Arts Curriculum materials will be presented to the Board today for approval. The Science Curriculum is still in the process of being aligned and will be brought to the Board this fall. Reviewing the Math Curriculum will take place next year during the school year. During the review process the curriculum will be aligned with the upcoming Alaska State Standards. When new curriculum is implemented, professional development will be available to all instructional staff. There was discussion.

- 6. Chairperson McGinty introduced Josie Dayton Principal/Teacher of Ella B. Vernetti School. Josie Dayton introduced her staff at the Ella B. Vernetti School along with her CSC Members. Currently we have 15 students, 4-preschoolers with 11 student K-8 grade. Josie thanked Kerry and the School Board for obtaining the money for the renovation of the restrooms. The showers are used by the community in Kovukuk and this was a much needed project. The healthy food program has been a huge benefit for the Ella B. Vernetti School, Much appreciated. The school thanks the Board for approving the field trip for Ella B. Vernetti School. We are looking forward to this field trip. Just came back from a Family Literacy Conference and I bring back more ways of bringing more literacy into the school along with ideas for parent involvement in the school. Some of my concerns are: the lack of generators, loud noise coming from the furnace, glycol leak, main water line is leaking, pressure hose is needed to clean up the bird nest and poop along the outside of the school and windows, handicapped ramp needs to be replaced as the wood is rotting and I find the children playing on the ramp, generator building is rotting out and the floor board is rotting as well. It would be great to have our chalk boards replaced with the white board as there are allergies and the chalk dust causes breakout. Thank you on behalf of the students in Ella B. Vernetti. There was discussion.
