The Yukon Koyukuk School Board has voted to open gym facilities for public use effective **Tuesday, December 14th 2021**. As a result, rental groups will be required to submit a COVID mitigation plan that includes the following minimum practices:

Self-Screening

All persons attending rental activities should practice self-screening before arrival. If any of the following symptoms are detected, or if you have been in contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID the individual should not attend.

- Fever of 100° F or more
- Chills
- Sore Throat
- Runny/Stuffiness Nose
- Coughing
- Shortness of Breath
- Headaches
- Body Aches or Tiredness
- Diarrhea
- Loss of Smell or Taste

Face Coverings

All persons over two years of age are to wear a face covering upon entering the School. Spectators are expected to remain masked at all times. Players and performers may remove masks while engaged in athletics, coaching, presentations, or performances.

Social Distancing

All attendees are encouraged to practice general social distancing whenever possible.

Cleaning of Equipment

General use areas, water fountains and equipment will need to be wiped down after use each evening

Limited Access

Participants may only be present during reserved times. All persons are to remain in the reserved area and not access neighboring spaces or hallways except to directly enter or exit the facility.

Any additional mitigation practices may be utilized at each group's discretion

The Yukon Koyukuk School District requires that these COVID mitigation practices are employed by all user groups. By submitting a COVID mitigation plan the user group acknowledges their responsibility to adhere to these practices and to prevent the spread of communicable disease.
