Who was the first responder to the spill and what was the first action taken?

First action to take is lock the gate, put up warning signs, and announce on radio keep all children & everyone away from tank farm.

What tank farm security measures were taken to contain the spill?

Put up warning signs and flag the area, estimate the amount of fuel spilled. Notify the city of Hughes & evacuate the school.

What precautions were taken to secure the public from the spill?

Notify the chief and the city of Hughes, and evacuate the school until it is safe to enter.

What PPE (Personal Protection Equipment) was used?

I would wear safety glasses, rubber boots, rubber gloves and respirator.
